José M F Moura is the Philip L. and Marsha Dowd University Professor at Carnegie Mellon University. His interests are in signal processing and data analytics. He has published over 550 technical papers and has been issued 15 patents; the technology of two of his patents (coinventor Alek Kavcic) is found in over three billion disk drives in about 60% of all computers sold in the world in the last 15 years. He is a Fellow of IEEE, AAAS, and of the National Academy of Inventors, a corresponding member of the Academia das Ciências de Portugal, and a member of the US National Academy of Engineers. He is the 2019 IEEE President and CeO.
